

Scoil Oilibhéir – Homework Policy

- All classes from Junior Infants to Sixth classes will get homework. Homework will be introduced to the Junior Infant classes during the course of the year, at a time when the class teachers deems it appropriate.
- All pupils do not necessarily get the same homework. Provision is made for children of differing ability.
- There will be a balance between oral, reading and written homework.
- Pupils in second to sixth classes will have a homework journal. Pupils in senior infants and first classes will have a homework copy.
- Parents are expected to check and sign the homework journal/copy on nights when homework is given.
- Homework is usually not given at the weekend.
- On special occasions pupils may be give homework off.
- The time guidelines for homework are as follows. These are guidelines only and may vary according to the class requirements:

Class Level:	Time Guideline:
Junior Infants	10 mins + Library Book
Senior Infants	10-15 mins + CAPER
First Class	15 mins + CAPER
Second Class	20 mins + CAPER
Third Class	30-35 mins + CAPER
Fourth Class	30-40 mins + library book
Fifth Class	45-50 mins
Sixth Class	60 mins
