



Scoil Oilibhéir - School Uniform Policy

All Pupils are required to wear the full school uniform.

The uniform consists of :

- ✓ Navy V-neck jumper with school crest and stripes on the V;
 - ✓ Blue shirt and school tie;
 - ✓ Grey pants and dark socks;
 - ✓ Navy pinafore with navy knee socks or tights / navy slacks;
 - ✓ Black or navy shoes....no runners please.

- Any other garments not listed above are not part of the school uniform and should not be worn.
 - For health and safety reasons the wearing of jewellery is not allowed except for watches and stud earrings. Make up is not allowed.
 - Pupils may wear the school tracksuit on PE days only. Runners must be worn for PE. In the event of a pupil not having a school tracksuit, the child must wear the uniform to school and bring sports gear in a bag for PE.

- ✓ During warm spells of weather parents have the **option** of sending your child to school in the summer uniform should you wish to do so. This means that there are 2 options for uniform in warm weather as follows:
 - ✓ The normal school uniform with the school tracksuit on PE days as is usually the case.
 - ✓ The summer uniform: this consists of the yellow polo t-shirt, school tracksuit top with the crested school shorts replacing the school tracksuit bottoms, white socks and runners.
 - ✓ **Only the school shorts from Buckley's will be allowed.** Children are not allowed to wear other sports shorts.
