SCHOOL CLOSURE MEMO 11

Dear Parent/Guardians,

I hope that you and those close to you are well and that the boys & girls of Scoil Oilibhéir are happy and healthy at this time, particularly with the fine weather.

As we head into the bank holiday weekend I wanted to remind you that Tuesday is a planned school closure and teachers and SNAs will be taking a well-earned rest, so they will see you all again on Seesaw on Wednesday.

We are approaching the end of the 2019/20 school year and our mind has turned towards finishing this school year strongly and preparing for the coming school year. I wanted to let you know about some of our plans for both as follows:

- The Board of Management has established a working group consisting of Board members, school staff and parents to plan for the re-opening of Scoil Oilibhéir. **As yet we have received no guidance from the DES about when and in what circumstances pupils will be returning in the autumn.** Once we receive this guidance we will let you know our plan, but in the meantime the Board of Management will work on making sure that everything is done to ensure that the school will be safe for staff, pupils and parents to return.
- We will be inviting all parents into the school on **June 18th & 19th** to collect your child's belongings from classrooms. On this visit we will also be asking you to return your child's book rental materials and their library books to the school. A further memo will issue to you with more detail regarding which day, times etc. soon and the teachers will be in touch with you via Seesaw to let you know what to drop back to us.

We wish, again, to thank all of our parents for your support to us throughout the school closure. It has been challenging for all of us and we certainly do not underestimate how much of a challenge this has been for you, our parents. I hope you all have a nice long weekend with your families and get the opportunity to enjoy some nice June sunshine.
